 - COVID-19 Program (2020)



Eviction Prevention Program

- Helps families and individuals who are experiencing a *crisis no fault of their own* and are at risk of becoming homeless.

Services provided:

- One-time financial assistance for back rent or deposit
- Budget counseling
- Connection to additional resources

Applicants:

- Able to substantiate a crisis
- *Show self-sufficiency*



COVID-19 Program

- Helps families and individuals that have been economically affected by COVID-19.

Services provided (contingent on funds)

- From one to up to six months of back rent
- Utility payments

Applicants:

- Show change in income
